Laurier graduates donate money to Anselma House

Just one day after the MBA class of 1989 receive their degrees from Wilfrid Laurier University, the graduates will return something to the community.

The class of 35 students is donating about \$1,000 to Anselma House in Kitchener. A cheque will be presented to a representative of the shelter for battered women at the MBA office in the Frank Peters Building May 29.

The money represents proceeds from advertising sold for the class yearbook.

Susan Leach, one of the graduates, said returning something to the community is one of the goals the class set a year ago.

The MBA program is a 12-month program for students who already hold an undergraduate degree and have two years' work experience.
