Chatham residents win awards at Wilfrid Laurier University

Five students from the Chatham area have won awards from Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo.

Brian Stienstra, Jeffrey Whittington, Marney Eddington, John Chinnick and Lynn Smith will be among 32 students recognized at a luncheon on campus Monday, March 19.

Stienstra and Whittington were both named Brent Scholars and will receive \$800 each as the highest-ranking students in the third year of an honors science program. Both are now in the fourth year of the honors computer and computer electronics program.

Stienstra, a graduate of Chatham Collegiate, is the 22-yearold son of Henry and Tina Stienstra of 120 Indian Creek Rd.

Whittington, a graduate of Ridgetown high school, is the 22-year-old son of Bill and June Whittington of RR# 3 Chatham.

Chinnick will receive an advanced scientific calculator from Hewlett-Packard Ltd., with a retail value of \$350, in recognition of being among the top students of his first-year honors

computing and computer electronics program last year. He is now in the second year of the program.

The 20-year-old son of Delbert and Margaret Chinnick of RR# 7 Chatham is a graduate of Tecumseh secondary school.

Eddington, now in her fourth year of an honors French program, will receive the \$265 W.D. Evans Award as an outstanding student in the program. The 21-year-old student is the daughter of Rick and Eva Eddington of 354 Victoria Ave. and a graduate of Chatham Collegiate.

Lynn Smith, who is in the fourth year of the honors religion and culture program, will receive \$150 as a co-winner of the Sally Jefferson Award. It is presented annually to outstanding students in that department.

Smith is the 23-year-old daughter of Weslie and Elizabeth Smith of 54 Elizabeth St. and a graduate of Tecumseh secondary school.

Laurier has about 5,000 undergraduate students in the faculties of arts and science, and music, and the school of business and economics.
