Expert in leadership development to speak at Laurier

Ann Morrison, author of Breaking the Glass Ceiling: Can Women Reach the Top of America's Largest Corporations?, will speak at Wilfrid Laurier University on Tuesday, Nov. 6.

Morrison will discuss the barriers that exist for women as they attempt to move up the corporate ranks toward top management positions.

The public lecture will begin at 4 p.m. in Room 1025 of the Frank C. Peters Building on the Waterloo campus.

A prolific author and expert in executive research and leadership development, Morrison is the director of the Leadership Diversity Group of the Centre for Creative Leadership in La Jolla, Calif.

Morrison has conducted executive training programs for Eastman Kodak, General Electric, IBM, and Westinghouse. Her articles have appeared in The New York Times, The Los Angeles Times, Psychology Today, and Small Business Reports.

She holds an MA degree in psychology from Bucknell University in Lewisburg, Pa., and an MBA from Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, N.C.
