- Description:** The three-day conference will include about 50 presentations and workshops on daily life for disadvantaged populations and the implications for helping those populations. They will explore neighborhood intervention strategies, programs for high-risk families, and the need to adapt clinical theory for disadvantaged populations.
- Keynote speakers include: John McKnight of Northwestern University on how disadvantaged populations can be incorporated into community life; Dr. Naomi Rae Grant of the University of Western Ontario on ecological perspectives on human development; and Katherine Wood of Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey on rethinking clinical theory and method. As of Sept. 27, there were about 300 registrants.
