Laurier student from St. Marys wins scholarships valued at \$3,600

Waterloo (Jan. 20) — A resident of St. Marys has distinguished herself by winning four academic awards at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo.

Coralee Coulthard, now in the fourth year of the honors business program at the university, will be honored at an annual awards luncheon for business and economics students on Wednesday, Jan. 22.

Coulthard won: the \$1,000 Arthur Anderson Accounting Scholarship, which is presented to a student entering fourth year who has an above average academic standing and has demonstrated leadership qualities; the \$1,600 Brent Scholarship as the highest ranking business and economics student in third year; the \$500 J.G. Brown Memorial Award for high standing in third year accounting and finance courses; and the \$500 Society of Management Accountants of Ontario Accounting Award of Merit for achieving the highest grade point average in four specific courses.

Coulthard recently represented Laurier in the accounting division of the national Inter-Collegiate Business Competition at Queen's University in Kingston. She and her partner, Jodi Ryan of Kirkland Lake, were finalists.

A 1988 graduate of St. Marys District Collegiate and Vocational Institute, Coulthard is the daughter of Ron and Ann Coulthard of RR# 2 St. Marys.
