Windsor resident wins \$2,000 scholarship at Wilfrid Laurier University

Waterloo, Ont. (March 26) — A Windsor resident has distinguished himself by winning a prestigious national scholarship at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo, Ont.

Sean Taylor, who is having a Canada Scholarship renewed, will be honored at the faculty of arts and science's annual awards luncheon on campus on Friday, March 27.

The \$2,000 scholarship is awarded by the federal government to reward academic excellence and encourage more of Canada's most promising students to choose careers in science and engineering. It is renewable up to three times for a total of up to \$8,000.

Taylor will also be among 10 students to be presented with calculators from Hewlett-Packard (Canada) Ltd. in recognition of academic excellence.

The son of Frank and Wilhelmeta Taylor is in the second year of the honors science program and majoring in biology and chemistry. He is a 1990 graduate of Hon. W.C. Kennedy Secondary School.

Amanda Terry of Belle River will be presented with the Mark Lindemann award. The \$170 scholarship is awarded to the student with the highest grade point average in two or more senior resource/land management courses.

Terry is in the fourth year of the honors geography program at Laurier. The daughter of Judith Dunlop, she is a 1988 graduate of Belle River District high school.
