Minden resident wins scholarships at Wilfrid Laurier University

Waterloo, Ont. (Feb. 20) — A Minden resident has won scholarships valued at \$2,950 at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo.

Angela Camelon, who graduated from Haliburton Highlands Secondary School in 1994 and is now in the first year of the honors chemistry program at Laurier, will be among 75 students honored at an awards ceremony at 4:30 p.m. on March 8 in the Maureen Forrester Recital Hall on campus.

Camelon will receive a Canada Scholarship. This \$2,500 scholarship is awarded by the federal government to reward academic excellence and encourage more of Canada's most promising students to choose careers in science and engineering. It is renewable up to three times for a total value of up to \$10,000.

She will also receive a \$450 Science Incentive Scholarship, awarded to students entering a science program with an average of more than 80 per cent.

Camelon is the 20-year-old son of David and Joanne Camelon, who live on Highway 121.
