Lunenburg resident wins scholarships at Wilfrid Laurier University

Waterloo, Ont. (Feb. 20) — A Lunenburg resident has won two scholarships valued at \$1,100 at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo.

Jason Woodside, who graduated from Rothwell-Osnabruck District High School in 1992 and is now in the third year of the honors computing and computer electronics program at Laurier, will be among 75 students honored at an awards ceremony at 4:30 p.m. on March 8 in the Maureen Forrester Recital Hall on campus.

Woodside will receive a \$1,000 Incentive Scholarship, awarded to students who earn an average of A- or better.

As well, he wins the \$100 Babcock and Wilcox Co-operative Education Work Report Award. It is awarded to the student in the honors computing and computer electronics program who submits the best work report from an internship.
