Ashton resident wins scholarships at Wilfrid Laurier University

Waterloo, Ont. (Feb. 20) — An Ashton resident has won scholarships valued at \$3,650 at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo.

Angela Quesnel, who graduated from St. Marks High School in Manotick in 1994 and is now in the first year of the honors mathematics program at Laurier, will be among 75 students honored at an awards ceremony at 4:30 p.m. on March 8 in the Maureen Forrester Recital Hall on campus.

Quesnel will receive a \$1,150 Laurier Scholarship, an entrance scholarship for students who enter with an average of 80 per cent or more. She will also receive a Canada Scholarship. This \$2,500 scholarship is awarded by the federal government to reward academic excellence and encourage more of Canada's most promising students to choose careers in science and engineering. It is renewable up to three times for a total value of up to \$10,000.

Quesnel is the 19-year-old daughter of Dennis and Edith Quesnel of Franktown Road in Ashton.
