Rosemary Fischer wins OCUFA teaching award

Dr. Rosemary Fischer, the founder of Wilfrid Laurier University's music therapy program, is one of seven winners of the 1995 Ontario Confederation of University Faculty Associations' teaching awards.

The awards are presented annually to academics who have shown exceptional teaching skills, as supported by statements from students, colleagues, administrators and alumni. Course development, instruction, and outreach are all documented in the nomination dossiers submitted to the OCUFA selection committee.

Fischer, a music therapist for more than 20 years and a Laurier faculty member for the past 10 years, was named Laurier's Outstanding Teacher in 1995.

She will receive the OCUFA teaching award in a special ceremony at the Delta Chelsea Inn, Toronto, on Friday, May 10.
