Journalist, historian Gwynne Dyer to present lecture

Journalist and historian Gwynne Dyer will present a lecture titled "The New Canada and the Globalization Shuffle; or First the Good News, then the Bad," on **Monday, October 21 at 8:00 pm in the Maureen Forrester Recital Hall** at Wilfrid Laurier University.

Dyer's lecture will focus on the much-changed relationship between English and French Canada, and how this relationship affects Canada's participation in the global market.

A freelance journalist and broadcaster, Dyer has received degrees from Canadian, American and British universities. He has produced a number of television documentaries focusing on international affairs and currently writes a twice weekly column on the subject that appears in 150 newspapers in 30 countries.
