Model First Ministers conference to explore national issues

WATERLOO, Ontario - University students from across Ontario and Quebec will debate national unity and the economy in a model First Ministers Conference scheduled for Friday, January 24 through Sunday, January 26, 1997 at Wilfrid Laurier University.

The students, from seven different universities, will represent provinces and interest groups in order to formulate resolutions, that according to conference organizers, would be significant proposals for consideration by the federal and provincial governments.

"First Ministers conferences are a valuable part of the political process," Tanya Staples, fourth year honours political science student and conference chair said. "We have tried to make this as accurate as we can in order for students to understand the important role Premiers play in working with national issues."

The conference will allow students to bring their perspectives to issues that face the nation, while getting first hand experience in the political process. In the committee sessions, the students will tackle the national unity question by examining divisional powers, and aboriginal self government. The nation's economy will be debated through an examination of provincial transfer payments and unemployment.

Member of Provincial Parliament, The Honourable Elizabeth Witmer, Ontario Minister of Labour, and Deputy Opposition House Leader, Alvin Curling, will open the conference on **Friday, January 24 at 5:00 p.m. in The Paul Martin Centre.**
