Groundbreaking to mark new Grad House

WATERLOO, Ontario - Bricker Avenue is getting some new neighbours.

On Monday, March 10, 1997, 1:00 p.m. at 24 Bricker Avenue, a special sod turning ceremony will mark the construction of a new \$300,000 facility for Wilfrid Laurier University graduate students. A reception in the Science Building Courtyard will follow the ceremony.

The new Grad House will replace two existing structures located at 22 and 24 Bricker Avenue. Major trees located at the site will be protected or relocated. The 4,600 square foot building, funded by a down payment from graduate students' fees and a loan from the University, was designed by Fergus-based architect James Fryett to complement the residential neighbourhood.

The 2,300 square foot upper level will be divided into two wings. The west wing houses administrative and office areas, while lounge space and a pub are featured in the east wing. The central area of the facility consists of a circulation area and a multipurpose room accessible to both wings. The remaining 2,300 square feet in the lower level is reserved for mechanical needs, storage and future uses. Space has been designated for an accessible lift to be added, and the building will be structurally capable of receiving a second storey.

The Graduate Students Association (GSA), in co-operation with Laurier's development office, is fundraising for fittings and furnishings. The GSA represents 640 full and part-time students enrolled in 13 graduate degree programs.
