WATERLOO – As the campus prepares for its first students, Laurier Brantford dean Arthur Read has announced the appointment of Tracy Arabski to the position of Brantford campus manager. Beginning September 1, Arabski joins professors Peter Farrugia, Gary Warrick and Leslie O'Dell as part of Laurier Brantford's full-time staff.

A graduate of North Park Collegiate Vocational School, Arabski is responsible for a number of areas at Laurier Brantford, including recruiting and staff management, administering the budget, preparing and monitoring campus information, and maintaining contact with Laurier's Waterloo campus. Aside from such administrative duties, she will also act as a resource for Brantford students, providing academic counseling and acting as a liaison with student services departments.

"The Brantford campus manager position requires someone who can work with the academic faculty and balance the demands of a number of administrative departments – a real multi-tasker," said Read. "This is the most senior staff position at Laurier Brantford and we're happy it could be filled by someone from the area."

Arabski holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in economics from McMaster University and brings eight years of experience as a thesis co-ordinator and a committee and calendar co-ordinator with McMaster's School of Graduate Studies.
