WATERLOO – Wilfrid Laurier University will this week host its fifth annual alumni awareness week, celebrating the post-university success of former students. Olympic gold medal winner Cheryl Pounder is one of the alumni returning to campus.

Notable alumni attending events tomorrow include WLU alumnus of the year and social work lobbyist, Dan Andreae (master of social work, 1980); Charlotte Gibson (master of arts, 1983), president and CEO of the Easter Seal Society; Glenn Coulson (bachelor of arts, 1997) and Joe Heslip (bachelor of music, 1998), actors and vocalists in music group VIP; and Robert Schlegel (bachelor of arts, 1972), president and CEO of Pavestone Co.

Students and faculty will play mini golf with the alumni between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. in the Concourse. A reception will follow in Alumni Hall.
