WATERLOO – The Robert Langen Gallery will showcase the talents of on-campus artists from Tuesday, March 18 to Saturday, March 29 during the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Laurier Art Show. The gallery will also host an opening reception from 4 to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, March 19 to introduce this year's display of artwork by students, staff and faculty.

The annual exhibition offers amateur and professional artists at Laurier an opportunity to display their work in a non-juried show. Some of the artists also sell their work. In previous years, artists have submitted paintings, sculptures, stained glass, photography and mixed-media works.

“Each year the gallery is overwhelmed by the amazing talent and exciting range of artwork,” says gallery curator Suzanne Luke. “There’s a great deal of artistic talent at Laurier and it is wonderful that participants are willing to share their work with the public.”

As Wilfrid Laurier University’s visual arts centre since 1989, the Robert Langen Gallery provides knowledge, stewardship, appreciation and enjoyment of Canadian art and culture to the local community. The gallery is located in the John Aird Centre and is open noon to 5 p.m. from Tuesday to Saturday. Admission is free.
