*Bob Rosehart completed high school in Tillsonburg, Ontario and received a Bachelor of Applied Science, a Master of Applied Science, and a PhD in Chemical Engineering from the University of Waterloo. In 1970 he joined the faculty of Lakehead University, becoming Dean of University Schools in 1977 and President in 1984. Bob has been a scientific counsellor to the Royal Commission on Electric Power Planning and a policy advisor to Environment Canada. He is a member of the Ontario Ministry of Education and Training Secondary School Reference Group, the Ontario Commission on Inter-University Athletics, and the Premier's Council. He has served on the Boards of Directors of the Ontario Energy Corporation and Rainy River Forest Products. Today he will be installed as the fifth President of Wilfrid Laurier University.*
