BRANTFORD – Laurier Brantford is again increasing its administrative staff to help properly manage the needs of a burgeoning campus. Ingrid Goll, former manager of health services at the Waterloo campus, has been appointed director of student services in Brantford.

"The appointment of Ingrid Goll is an important step forward for Laurier Brantford," said Leo Groarke, dean of Wilfrid Laurier University's campus in Brantford. "She brings to the campus a solid background in student services, positive relations with the student services departments on our Waterloo campus, and an interest in the development of a comprehensive range of services for Brantford students."

Goll is a registered nurse and has worked at Laurier for the last six years, four of those as the manager of health services. As director, she assumes responsibility for significantly expanding and improving the support that the campus provides to its students. Her portfolio includes residential services, counseling services, career services, health services, accessible learning, athletics and cultural services.

The Brantford campus has added 10 new full-time faculty and five new full- or part-time staff positions so far this academic year to keep pace with the growth in the student body. While final registration numbers will not be compiled until late October, Laurier Brantford now has close to 1,000 students.
