WATERLOO – The Robert Langen Art Gallery will host an opening reception for the annual juried exhibition of the Waterloo Potters' Workshop from 1 to 4 p.m. on Sunday, May 7. The show, entitled Earthborn 2006, will be on exhibition until Thursday, May 18.

Earthborn 2006 is hosted by the Canadian Clay & Glass Gallery, the Kitchener-Waterloo Art Gallery, Homer Watson House & Gallery, Harbinger Gallery, the University of Waterloo Art Gallery and the Robert Langen Art Gallery at WLU. This year's juror is Bruce Taylor, a professor of fine arts at the University of Waterloo. Eleven awards will be given out in association with the exhibition, including the prestigious Ontario Crafts Council Design Award.

The Waterloo Potters' Workshop was established in 1967. In addition to the annual juried exhibition, the workshop holds two sales annually at the Waterloo Memorial Recreation Complex as well as pottery classes for adults and children throughout the year.

As Wilfrid Laurier University's visual arts centre since 1989, the Robert Langen Art Gallery provides knowledge, stewardship, appreciation and enjoyment of Canadian art and culture to the local community. The gallery is located in the John Aird Centre and is open for this exhibition from 1–4 p.m., Sunday to Thursday.

Admission is free.
