WATERLOO — Wilfrid Laurier University and the union representing the university's Contract Academic Staff have agreed to resume contract talks.

Negotiators for the two sides will meet Thursday April 3.

There have been no contract talks since March 19 when the Wilfrid Laurier University Faculty Association, which represents the Part-time Contract Academic Staff and Part-time Librarians, directed the bargaining unit to go on strike. The university invited the union to meet again, and the union has agreed.

"We are very pleased to be going back to the bargaining table," said Laurier president Dr. Max Blouw. "For the sake of the entire Laurier community, and especially our students, we want to reach a fair and responsible settlement as soon as possible."
