Waterloo Lutheran Seminary

was founded in 1911 and celebrated its Golden Anniversary with special services and lectures in September, 1961. From the ivy-circled doors of Willison Hall have emerged 161 graduates to advance the life and work of the Church. These now serve in seven provinces, the United States, India and South America. Without these native sons trained for leadership by our Seminary, our Church in Canada could never have achieved its rapid growth in recent years. The Seminary has truly been a strong, sustaining arm of the Church.

Waterloo University College

is the Faculty of Arts of our University. Since its birth in 1924 over 3,000 students have received a Christian College Education in the Humanities to prepare them for every walk of life. Our Auxiliary has been a supporter of the work of the College since its inception. We have provided furnishings for dormitory rooms in Willison Hall, class rooms and offices, gymnasium equipment, substantial gifts toward the library, dining hall equipment, together with \$10,000 for maintenance.

Waterloo University College and Waterloo Lutheran Seminary are expanding rapidly. We'll continue the good work our auxiliary started in 1913 and meet the challenge of our role as foster mothers of our own university.
