#### THROUGH THE YEARS

- 1911 THE FIRST WATERLOO COLLEGE RUGBY TEAM CONSISTED OF TWENTY PLAYERS AND ONE COACH.
- 1928 THE OPENING OF SEAGRAM MEMORIAL FIELD.
  DR. LLOYD SCHAUS, MUCH LOVED AND RESPECTED PROFESSOR OF RELIGION AND CULTURE, WAS ON THE RUGBY TEAM THAT DAY.
- 1939-1950 THE WAR IN EUROPE FIGURED IN THE THOUGHTS OF ALL AT WATERLOO COLLEGE. MANY GRADUATE ATHLETES JOINED THE SERVICES AND CORRESPONDENCE WAS EAGERLY SOUGHT FROM ALUMNI SERVING IN ALL PARTS OF THE WORLD. THE WAR YEARS WERE SERIOUS TIMES FOR WATERLOO COLLEGE; HOWEVER, BETTER TIMES WERE TO COME.
- 1951-1960 THE WATERLOO EXPANSION PROGRAM INVOL-VED A TOTAL COST OF ALMOST \$700,000.
- 1961-1970 THE 60'S WERE A DECADE OF INCREDIBLE ACTIVITY FOR WLU. THE BASKETBALL HAWKS IN 1968 WENT OFF TO THE CANADIAN UNIVERSITY FINALS AS UNKNOWNS AND CAME BACK AS CANADIAN CHAMPIONS! THE FOOTBALL HAWKS IN 1966 AND 1968 MADE IT TO THE COLLEGE BOWL.





## GOLDEN HAWKS NEWS RELEASE HAWKS DEFEAT GEE-GEES 23-10

By defeating the University of Waterloo 44-8 the Golden Hawks qualified for the play-offs and travelled to Ottawa to meet the Gee-Gees, 1st place finishers in the EAST-ERN SECTION. It was far from an ideal afternoon for football, since the CFL teams played on Saturday. By game time on Sunday, two inches of snow had made the field almost unplayable. The Hawks came out smoking, and after trading field goals with the favoured GEE-GEES, took complete control of the game. At the half, it was 23-3.

The second half was good defensive football by both clubs, but neither offensive unit could get going in the ankle deep mud. Ottawa managed to score a converted touchdown in the last two minutes of play.

Again it was the triple-option that was the main offensive threat for the Golden Hawks, as they ran for almost 400 yards. Ted Passmore accounted for 126, and Fred McLean added 57. Gerry Blacker ran for 75 yards and one TD and trigger man Wayne Allison rushed for 125 and one TD. Rookie Tim Pickett caught an "Allison bomb" for the other touchdown, while Wally Parker contributed a field goal and two converts.

Defensive praise should go to the entire unit as every man played his finest game. While limiting the vaunted Ottawa running game to a meagre 89 yards, the Hawks collected 4 interceptions. Special praise should go to Tackle Tom Balfe, Linebackers Parker and Jim Cooper and deepback Gary Duffy.


The winner in QUEBEC will travel to EDMONTON, ALBERTA to face the University of Alberta. This survivor will play in the College Bowl.

To the winner the covered VANIER CUP symbolic of national supremacy.


