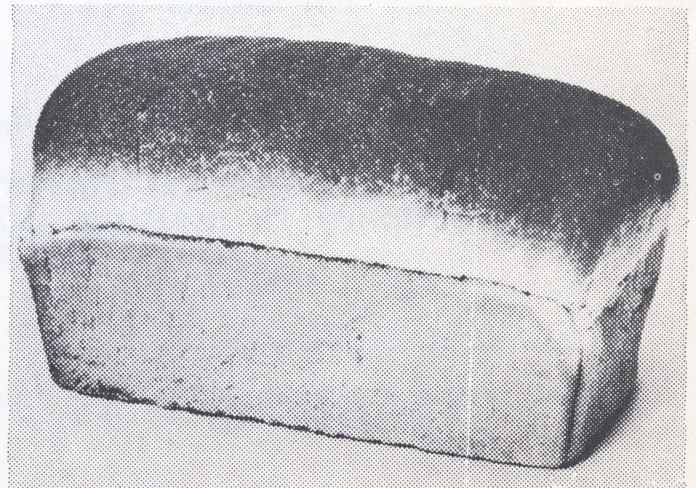

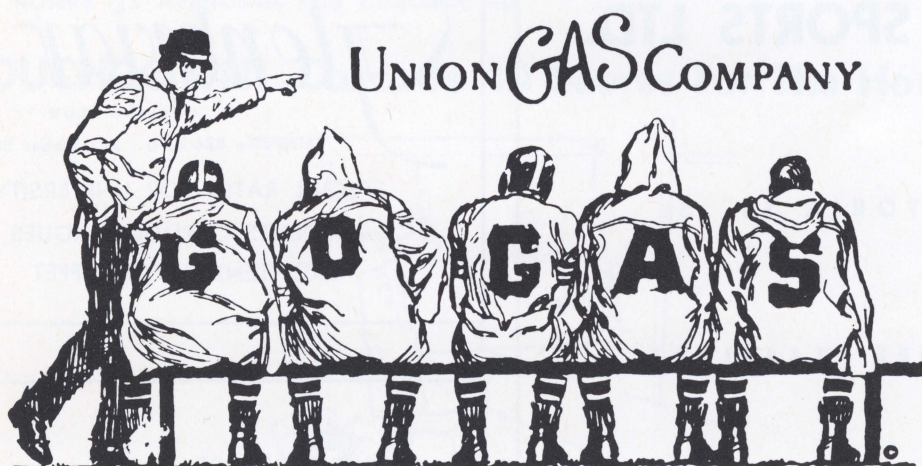
## The W.L.U. "Golden Hawks"

**First Down**  
Arm raised, then pointed toward defensive team's goal.



**Offside, Encroaching or Free Kick Violation**  
Hands on hips.



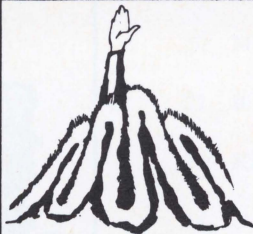
**Illegal Motion at Snap**  
Horizontal arc with either hand.



**Safety**  
Palms together over head.



**Time-Out**  
Hands criss-crossed over head.  
**Touchback**  
Same signal followed by arms swung at side.



**Time-Out**  
Repair artificial turf



**Time-Out**  
Remove dog from field



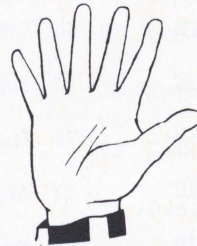
**Interference with Fair Catch or Forward Pass**  
Pushing hand forward from shoulder with hands vertical.



**Unsportsmanlike Conduct**  
Arms outstretched, palms down.  
(Same signal means continuing action fouls are disregarded.)



**Time-Out**  
Remove drunk from field



**Distance for First Down**  
Six yards to go



**No Time-Out or Time-In with Whistle**  
Full arm circles to simulate winding clock.



**Personal Foul**  
Striking of one wrist above head.



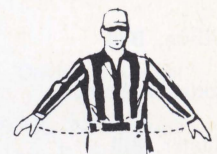

One arm aloft, open hand. (With fist closed—Fourth Down)



**Holding or Illegal Use of Hands or Arms**  
Grasping of one wrist.



**Touchdown, Field Goal or Successful Try**  
Both arms extended above head.



**Illegal Forward Pass**  
Waving hands behind back.  
**Intentional Grounding of Pass**—Same as above followed by raised hand flung downward.

















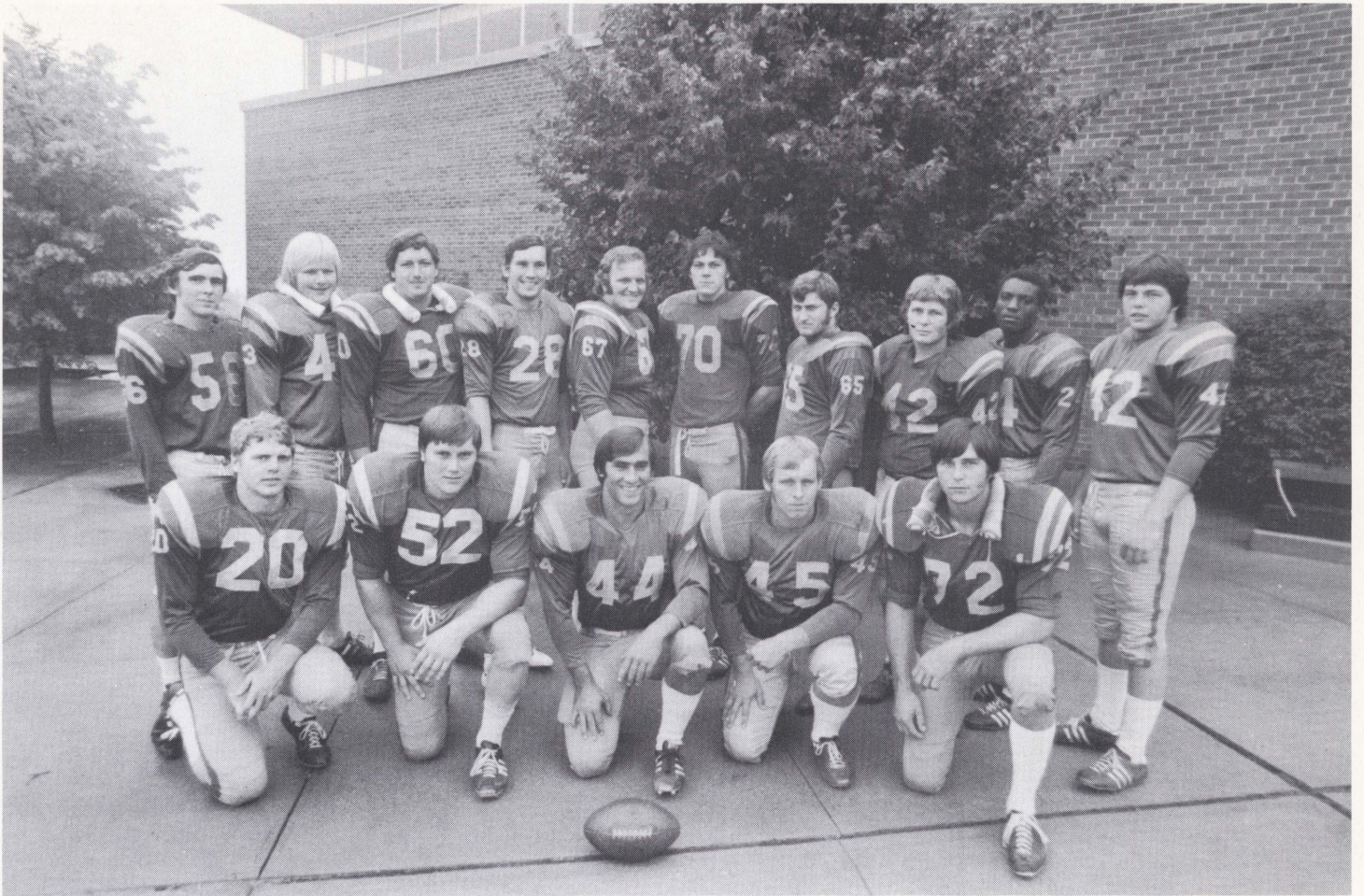
