Laurier Summer Camp Fair lets families plan their summer in one evening

WATERLOO – Representatives from 40 summer camps and programs will host exhibits at Wilfrid Laurier University's 2013 Summer Camp Fair, giving parents one-stop access to summer camp options for their children. The fair takes place Thursday, Feb. 21 from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the Science Building courtyard on Laurier's Waterloo campus.

"The fair gives parents and children a chance to meet representatives from many camps and ask questions about their programs in person," said organizer Rebecca Kieswetter. "We hope it will make it easier for families to choose the camp that's right for their children."
