ITS ACHIEVEMENTS

The Women's Auxiliary of Waterloo College made up of women who believe they can make a definite contribution to the advancement of God's plan by giving their consecrated help to the promotion of His Ideals in the educating of young men and young women. If the leadership of the future is to be vitally useful, it must be directed according to His Plan. The Women's Auxiliary, from its very beginning, has placed its full effort behind the program of keeping the Christian ideal of life definitely before the student body of Waterloo College.

In this year of 1949, the Auxiliary completes thirty-six years of this service. Its members look back with gratitude and degree of satisfaction upon its accomplishments. And they are planning with an increasing zeal and devotion for still greater achievements in the future.

#### - ORGANIZATION AND MEMBERSHIP -

The Auxiliary was organized in 1913 and its membership extends from Sault Ste Marie to the Atlantic Coast in Nova Scotia. Representatives from the various communities attend the General Conference which is held annually in June. In this way each Auxiliary participates actively in all the purposes and policies of the General Society.

Any woman interested in the program of the Auxiliary may become a member by the payment of One Dollar (\$1.00) annually. Men may become honorary members on the same terms.

From its inception the Auxiliary was responsible for the furnishing of dormitory rooms. A few years ago dormitories were refurnished, the Auxiliary securing \$100. gifts from individuals or groups to obtain the necessary funds for this project. On the door of each room a plate was placed

bearing the name of the donor. Then too, furnishings for classrooms and offices were supplied - the gymnasium equipped - annual grants made to the science department - a large sum of money donated to furnish chemistry laboratory - library was increased through the generosity of the Women's Auxiliary - \$10,000. was donated for maintenance.

With the introduction of co-education the furnishing of a Girls Common Room and Rest Room became necessity - and now we have acquired a large dwelling which will be used temporarily as a Girls' Dormitory. This has been completely and comfortably furnished. The furnishing for the veterans quarters were also supplied by the Auxiliary, as well as the equipment and the entire remodelling of our present modern kitchen and serving room. \$500. was donated towards remodelling the President's home and \$500. for repairs to Professor's home.

The immediate project of the Auxiliary is to provide a fund of \$25,000. towards the building of a new Girls' Dormitory. It is hoped this amount will be realized within five years.

In addition to these major projects the Auxiliary has sponsored a large number of lesser objectives but all guided by the program of enriching the spiritual environment of the students at Waterloo.

The grand total of contributions of the Auxiliary during these thirty-six years is approximately \$75,000.

#### - METHODS EMPLOYED -

Each Auxiliary collects its own membership dues and reports them to the Treasurer of the General Auxiliary.

Many of the sub-Auxiliaries put on various kinds of money-raising projects in their own communities to supplement their dues. In addition to the dues and these local methods, a number of

general cooperative projects have been worked out.

- WHAT CAN YOU DO? -

The Women's Auxiliary invites you to participate by making any dedicatory contribution you may wish in order that our whole program may be pressed forward.

Above all, the Women's Auxiliary invites you to cooperate in promoting Christian character, and culture at Waterloo College by becoming an active member of the Women's Auxiliary. After becoming a member and participating in its activities, you will find yourself so inspired by the record and the ideal of the College as a Christian institution, that you will be spurred on to still greater efforts in her behalf. Waterloo College was founded by the Church. She has not forgotten her mother.
