The lawsuit for the possession of the Baden Church between the Canada & Mo. Synods was tried yesterday and to-day. The judge reserved his decision and gave them fatherly advice to settle the matter among themselves in a Christian way. But as neither side has enough grace for that I suppose he will eventually give his decision. I saw Pastor's Penman only for a few minutes at the time of the Board meeting. He seems to be quite happy with his new wife. Well, I must close.
