Upper Canada Colonists lawfully appointed by the Rev.
Mr. Myers Clergyman for the Lutheran Congregation of this
parish in the name of the said congregation and behalf of our
successors for divers considerations and good causes us hereunto
moving having made ordained constituted and appointed and by
these presents do make ordain constitute and appoint Henry Mer-
kley of Williamsburg County District and province aforesaid Esq.
our true and lawful Attorney for us and in our names to ask
Demand recover or receive out of the secretaries Office at York
a patent Deed of the Large Land granted to the Lutheran
Church lying and being a reserve between Lots number Eighteen and
Nineteen first Concession of said township of Williamsburg granting
to our said Attorney our full power and Authority to take pursue and
follow such legal courses for the recovery receiving and obtaining
as we ourselves could do were we personally present and upon the receipts
of the same acquitances and other sufficient discharges to make
sign seal and deliver as also one or more Attorney or Attorneys under
him to substitute or appoint ratifying and confirming whatsoever our
said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the execution
of the premises by virtue of these presents in witness whereof we have
hereunto set our hands and seals this seventh Day of October in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen
