Laurier to sign agreement with Jusoor Syria to sponsor scholarships for Syrian youth

WATERLOO – Wilfrid Laurier University will become the first Canadian university to sign a memorandum of understanding with **Jusoor Syria**, a non-governmental organization dedicated to connecting Syrian youth with post-secondary education scholarships.

Jusoor's Canadian representative **Leen Al Zaibak** and Laurier President and Vice-Chancellor **Max Blouw** will sign the agreement **April 20** at **1:30 p.m.** in the Ernst & Young Board Room of the Schlegel Centre on the university's Waterloo campus.

Laurier will partner with Jusoor's "100 Syrian Women, 10,000 Syrian Lives" scholarship program to sponsor four female Syrian students, three undergraduate and one graduate, to study at Laurier as early as fall 2016.
