The Convocation Ceremony

Convocation is the most solemn ceremony within the university community. Since their beginnings in the Middle Ages, universities have performed this ceremony in order to grant degrees to their students and also to welcome those students into the community of scholars which has trained them.

The conferring of the degree is symbolized either by an acknowledgement or handshake from the chancellor or the president or other conferring officers of the university.

As an outward sign of his or her new state, the student wears a hood. Each degree within a university has a hood of unique colours and trim in order that the student's status may be recognized—indeed every university guards its own set of hoods from use by any other university.

The Wilfrid Laurier University Mace

The mace of Wilfrid Laurier University was officially presented by the Euler family at the 1963 fall convocation in memory of The Honourable W.D. Euler, former senator of Canada and the first chancellor of the university. It weighs 16 pounds and was manufactured by the firm of Henry Birks Limited, Montreal.

The ferrule near the base of the shaft contains ivory from a walrus tusk obtained from Coral Harbour, Northwest Territories. The shaft, representing the 10 provinces, merges into the head of the mace which bears the provincial crests. The wood used at the point where the shaft meets the head of the mace is elm taken from the bannister post of Conrad Hall, the original seminary building. Above this are four crests relating to the history of the institution: a crest of Waterloo County, the Luther Coat of Arms, the crest of the Waterloo Lutheran Seminary and the coat of arms of the University of Western Ontario.

The head of the mace is made of maple and bears the Federal Coat of Arms, above which is the monogram of Queen Elizabeth II, during whose reign the university's charter was granted. On the reverse side is the crest of Wilfrid Laurier University and the monogram of King George V, during whose reign the original charter was granted. The top of the mace is a crown, mounted with jewels, symbolizing the authority of the State.

The Marshal's Baton

Dr. Fred Binding, a faculty member in the Department of Psychology for 32 years retired in July 2003. He had served as the university marshal for 10 years. Sadly, Dr. Binding died in August 2003. In memory of his contribution to convocation ceremonies, artist Rex Lingwood was commissioned to create a marshal's baton.

In the baton, there's a range of visual references that relate to the graduation ceremony, both directly and symbolically. The baton's design echoes the elaborate theatricality of the ceremony and the flair brought to the occasion by Dr. Binding.

The commission of the baton was made possible with the generous support of the Department of Psychology and Wilfrid Laurier University Retirees' Association.

Honorary Degrees and Other Awards

Honorary degrees are conferred by Wilfrid Laurier University in recognition of outstanding scholarly, creative, or professional achievement or distinguished public and community service. The university may grant the following honorary degrees: Doctor of Laws (LLD), Doctor of Letters (DLitt), Doctor of Science (DSc) and Doctor of Divinity (DDiv).

The Order of Wilfrid Laurier honours worthy recipients who have a record of exemplary and distinguished service to the university.

The Wilfrid Laurier University Awards for Teaching Excellence honours faculty members who excel in teaching. Categories recognize sustained excellence in teaching, teaching innovation and early career excellence.

The Teaching Assistant Award of Excellence was established in 2007. The award aims to recognize the outstanding achievement of a Teaching Assistant or Instructional Assistant at Laurier.

The Distinguished Governor Award provides a mechanism for recognizing retiring and retired members of the Board of Governors who have given outstanding service to Laurier.

The University Research Professor Award recognizes and rewards a continuous record of outstanding scholarship or creativity by a full-time member of the Laurier faculty.

The Award for Service Excellence and Community Engagement for Faculty and Librarians recognizes individuals who in addition to their teaching and scholarship, provide exceptional service leadership.

The Academic Degrees

The academic degree is a title conferred on an individual by a university as recognition of the completion of a course of study or for a certain attainment. In Canada, the three stages in higher education are represented by the degrees of bachelor, master, and doctor. Wilfrid Laurier University is given the authority to grant degrees by the Wilfrid Laurier University Act.

The bachelor's degree is awarded at the honours, without honours or general specified, and the general level. An honours degree program emphasizes the acquisition of a broad and deep knowledge of the student's chosen honours subject. The four-year BA without honours or general, is awarded to students who have met all honours course requirements and includes their specialization. A general degree program emphasizes a balance between an in-depth understanding of the student's major subject and a knowledge and appreciation of other fields.

The master's degree is the second degree in higher education. Students complete concentrated and specialized work at a more advanced level in an academic discipline or professional area. Most course work is within the field of specialization and a research project or thesis is normally required. Some master's degrees provide professional qualifications.

The doctoral degree is the highest academic degree granted by a university. Candidates for the degree spend several years in the advanced study of a specialized field of knowledge. The capstone of the degree is the doctoral dissertation, an extended work based upon independent research. The dissertation demonstrates the candidate's command of both the subject matter and the exacting methods of scholarship, and makes an original contribution to knowledge.

Unique Ceremonial Stole for Aboriginal Graduates

Self-identified Aboriginal graduates on the Brantford campus will receive a unique stole with symbolic meaning. One side of the stole depicts the Dish with one Spoon Treaty Wampum Belt. For the Haudenosaunee and the Anishnaabe, the Dish with one Spoon marked the end of violent conflict in the hunting grounds surrounding the Great Lakes. The spoon represents a symbolic lesson to avoid sharp instruments which can cause the spilling of blood. The symbolism that we all eat from one dish with one spoon demonstrates the collective responsibility of the people to share equally. On the other side of the stole, the Kahswentha: Two Row Wampum Treaty Belt is a reminder of the historic relationship and mutual respect between Canada's Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal Peoples. The Two Row Wampum depicts two parallel rows of purple beads which symbolize paths for two vessels: a canoe and a ship. The two vessels are forever parallel, pursuing parallel paths, never interfering with each other. Between the two paths of purple are three rows of white beads depicting the River of Life, symbolizing peace, respect and friendship.

Eagle Feathers

Eagle feathers are presented to those individuals as a traditional rite of passage, who demonstrated dedication, commitment and determination throughout their learning journeys in the Aboriginal Field of Study, Master of Social Work Program. Traditionally, in Aboriginal cultures, Eagle Feathers were bestowed upon those who had undergone challenges in their growth, learning and healing. The Eagle is one of our sacred helpers and messenger to the Creator, and the Eagle Feather is a sacred symbol of strength, leadership and spiritual growth.

The Matters Before All Else

The Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen is often publically referred to as the Haudenosaunee Thanksgiving Address, but such a simplistic translation can be problematic. A closer, more literal translation of the words Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen would be The Leading Order of Business or The Matters Before All Else. This phrase comes directly from Haudenosaunee Oral History and refers back to our Creation Narrative.

Our history reminds us that once the Creator had finished preparing the Earth and everything was as he intended, he gathered the human beings and shared simple instructions. The first duty and responsibility of the Onkwehón:we (the Original Beings), was to always be thankful and to honour the Natural World. Whenever more than three people gathered together, we are obliged to first remind each other of everything in Creation that sustains and supports the Human Being. To the best of our ability, we are to recite the name of each Element and reiterate all the work they do on our behalf so that life on Earth may continue.

This recitation also reminds us to be humble and gentle in our actions as we mingle about on our Mother, the Earth. It reminds us of our human frailty and instability. While we are completely dependent on everything in Creation to sustain us, that same Creation would survive and flourish without us.

It is an incredible honour to be able to continue these ancient traditions on our original territories in our original languages. It speaks to the fortitude and resilience of our ancestors that we continue to share our traditional Haudenosaunee teachings with the Newcomers to our lands.

While there is a general, overall pattern to the Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen, there is not a single correct version. It is unique to the individual who has been chosen to put those words through on our behalf. The version a speaker chooses will depend on the situation and the reason for the gathering. When we are in ceremony and, being thankful is of primary importance, a speaker may take up to an hour to complete the recitation. In other situations the length of the Address will be shortened to a simple grocery list similar to the one that is delivered in social functions such as this convocation. It could take as little as five minutes.

Shonkwahtsi:'a Entye'kenékha Karáhkwa, Our Older Brother the Sun

Yethi'shótha Ahsontennékha Karáhkwa, Our Grandmother the Moon

Kayé:ri niyonkwè:take, The Four Beings

Shonkwaya'tíson, Our Creator

The speaker will then turn back to the people gathered and reiterate that he did the best that he was able and if anything had been missed or forgotten that the people can make it right in their minds.

Chancellor's Installation

EILEEN MERCIER Installation Ceremony, October 28, 2 p.m.



At Wilfrid Laurier University, our highest aspiration is to inspire lives of leadership and purpose. There is no better exemplar of this ideal than Eileen Mercier, one of the university's most distinguished alumna.

An accomplished business leader, corporate governance expert and active volunteer, Ms. Mercier has earned the respect and affection of all those with whom she has worked. She is among the first women in Canada to build a career in corporate governance. She is a Fellow of the Institute of Corporate Directors

and a Fellow of the Institute of Canadian Bankers. She was named one of Canada's Top 25 Women of Influence in 2011 and has twice been named one of Canada's Top 100 Most Powerful Women. She has been awarded honorary doctorates from both Laurier and York University.

Ms. Mercier has more than 45 years of leadership experience in a variety of roles and industries. She currently serves as the chair of the board of directors of Payments Canada, the organization responsible for the clearing and settlement of financial transactions in Canada. Previously, Ms. Mercier served as chair of the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan board and is the former president of Finvoy Management Inc. and a former senior vice-president and chief financial officer of Abitibi-Price Inc. Over the course of her highly successful career, she has served on the boards of many other corporations, as well as the boards of health-care and arts organizations.

For Ms. Mercier, education has been a lifelong passion and the foundation for personal and professional growth. She graduated in 1968 from Waterloo Lutheran University, later renamed Wilfrid Laurier University, with a Bachelor of Arts in English and an academic gold medal. She went on to earn a master's degree in English from the University of Alberta. Her arts education helped her land a job in the communications department of the Toronto Stock Exchange. She later joined the Toronto Dominion Bank and, after two years, began studying for an MBA at York University. From there, she rose to ever more senior roles in the business world.

Throughout her career Ms. Mercier has remained close to Laurier. She served on the university's Board of Governors for many years, including a term as chair from 1988 to 1990. In 1991, she received the university's Outstanding Business Leader Award. During the university's centennial in 2011, she was named one of our 100 Alumni of Achievement. In 2013, the university awarded her an honorary doctor of laws degree. She is an active member of the university's President's Council of Advisors and the Campaign Cabinet, as well as a longtime member of the Laurier Alumni Choir.

As the university embarked on a search to find its next Chancellor, those responsible for identifying candidates were asked to nominate a "person of stature, respect and impeccable character"; someone who "embodies the cultural values and intrinsic qualities of Laurier"; and a "champion for higher education." Ms. Mercier possesses all of these qualities and more.

It is with great pride, confidence and enthusiasm that we welcome Eileen Mercier as the new Chancellor of Wilfrid Laurier University.
