The Convocation Ceremony

Convocation is the most solemn ceremony within the university community. Since their beginnings in the Middle Ages, universities have performed this ceremony in order to grant degrees to their students and also to welcome those students into the community of scholars, which has trained them.

The conferring of the degree is symbolized either by an acknowledgement or handshake from the chancellor or the president or other conferring officers of the university.

As an outward sign of his or her new state, the student wears a hood. Each degree within a university has a hood of unique colours and trim in order that the student's status may be recognized – indeed every university guards its own set of hoods from use by any other university.

The Wilfrid Laurier University Mace

The mace of Wilfrid Laurier University was officially presented by the Euler family at the 1963 fall convocation in memory of The Honourable W.D. Euler, former senator of Canada and the first chancellor of the university. It weighs 16 pounds and was manufactured by the firm of Henry Birks Limited, Montreal.

The ferrule near the base of the shaft contains ivory from a walrus tusk obtained from Coral Harbour, Northwest Territories. The shaft, representing the 10 provinces, merges into the head of the mace which bears the provincial crests. The wood used at the point where the shaft meets the head of the mace is elm taken from the bannister post of Conrad Hall, the original seminary building. Above this are four crests relating to the history of the institution: a crest of Waterloo County, the Luther Coat of Arms, the crest of the Waterloo Lutheran Seminary and the coat of arms of the University of Western Ontario.

The head of the mace is made of maple and bears the Federal Coat of Arms, above which is the monogram of Queen Elizabeth II, during whose reign the university's charter was granted. On the reverse side is the crest of Wilfrid Laurier University and the monogram of King George V, during whose reign the original charter was granted. The top of the mace is a crown, mounted with jewels, symbolizing the authority of the State.

The Marshal's Baton

Dr. Fred Binding, a faculty member in the Department of Psychology for 32 years retired in July 2003. He had served as the university marshal for 10 years. Sadly, Dr. Binding died in August 2003. In memory of his contribution to convocation ceremonies, artist Rex Lingwood was commissioned to create a marshal's baton.

In the baton, there's a range of visual references that relate to the graduation ceremony, both directly and symbolically. The baton's design echoes the elaborate theatricality of the ceremony and the air brought to the occasion by Dr. Binding.

The commission of the baton was made possible with the generous support of the Department of Psychology and Wilfrid Laurier University Retirees' Association.

Honorary Degrees and Other Awards

Honorary degrees are conferred by Wilfrid Laurier University in recognition of outstanding scholarly, creative, or professional achievement or distinguished public and community service. The university may grant the following honorary degrees: Doctor of Laws (LLD), Doctor of Letters (DLitt), Doctor of Science (DSc) and Doctor of Divinity (DDiv).

The Order of Wilfrid Laurier University honours worthy recipients who have a record of exemplary and distinguished service to the university.

The Donald F. Morgenson Faculty Awards for Teaching Excellence honour faculty members who excel in teaching. Categories recognize sustained excellence in teaching, teaching innovation and early career excellence.

The Laurier Student Teaching Award of Excellence was established in 2007. The award aims to recognize the outstanding achievement of a Teaching Assistant or Instructional Assistant at Laurier.

The Distinguished Governor Award provides a mechanism for recognizing retiring and retired members of the Board of Governors who have given outstanding service to Laurier.

The University Research Professor Award recognizes and rewards a continuous record of outstanding scholarship or creativity by a full-time member of the Laurier faculty.

The Faculty Award for Service Excellence and Community Engagement recognizes individuals who in addition to their teaching and scholarship, provide exceptional service leadership.

The Academic Degrees

The academic degree is a title conferred on an individual by a university as recognition of the completion of a course of study or for a certain attainment. In Canada, the three stages in higher education are represented by the degrees of bachelor, master and doctor. Wilfrid Laurier University is given the authority to grant degrees by the Wilfrid Laurier University Act.

The bachelor's degree is awarded at the honours, without honours or general specified, and the general level. An honours degree program emphasizes the acquisition of a broad and deep knowledge of the student's chosen honours subject. The four-year BA without honours or general, is awarded to students who have met all honours course requirements and includes their specialization. A general degree program emphasizes a balance between an in-depth understanding of the student's major subject and a knowledge and appreciation of other fields.

The master's degree is the second degree in higher education. Students complete concentrated and specialized work at a more advanced level in an academic discipline or professional area. Most course work is within the field of specialization and a research project or thesis is normally required. Some master's degrees provide professional qualifications.

The doctoral degree is the highest academic degree granted by a university. Candidates for the degree spend several years in the advanced study of a specialized field of knowledge. The capstone of the degree is the doctoral dissertation, an extended work based upon independent research. The dissertation demonstrates the candidate's command of both the subject matter and the exacting methods of scholarship and makes an original contribution to knowledge.

Unique Ceremonial Stole for Indigenous Graduates

Indigenous graduates will receive a unique stole with symbolic meaning. One side of the stole depicts the Dish with One Spoon Treaty Wampum Belt between the Haudenosaunee and Anishnaabe. For them, the Dish with One Spoon marked the end of violent conflict in the hunting grounds surrounding the Great Lakes. The Spoon teaches us to avoid sharp instruments which can cause the spilling of blood. The belt describes that we all eat from one dish with one spoon and demonstrates the collective responsibility of the people to share equally. On the other side of the stole, the Kahswentha: Two Row Wampum Treaty Belt is a reminder of the historic relationship and mutual respect between the Haudenosaunee and early settlers. The belt has now come to represent the relationship between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people sharing the land in Canada. The Two Row Wampum depicts two parallel rows of purple beads which symbolize paths for two vessels: a canoe and a ship. The two vessels are forever parallel, pursuing parallel paths, never interfering with each other. Between the two paths of purple and three rows of white beads depicting the River of Life, symbolizing peace, respect and friendship.



Eagle Feathers

Eagle feathers are presented to those individuals as a traditional rite of passage, who demonstrated dedication, commitment and determination throughout their learning journeys in the Indigenous Field of Study, Master of Social Work Program. Traditionally, in Indigenous cultures, eagle feathers were bestowed upon those who had undergone challenges in their growth, learning and healing. The Eagle is one of our sacred helpers and messenger to the Creator, and the eagle feathers is a sacred symbol of strength, leadership and spiritual growth.

The Matters Before All Else

The Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen is often publicly referred to as the Haudenosaunee Thanksgiving Address, but such a simplistic translation can be problematic. A closer, more literal translation of the words Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen would be The Leading Order of Business or The Matters Before All Else. This phrase comes directly from Haudenosaunee Oral History and refers back to our Creation Narrative.

Our history reminds us that once the Creator had finished preparing the Earth and everything was as he intended, he gathered the human beings and shared simple instructions. The first duty and responsibility of the Onkwehón:we (the Original Beings), was to always be thankful and to honour the Natural World. Whenever more than three people gathered together, we are obliged to first remind each other of everything in Creation that sustains and supports the Human Being. To the best of our ability, we are to recite the name of each Element and reiterate all the work they do on our behalf so that life on Earth may continue.

This recitation also reminds us to be humble and gentle in our actions as we mingle about on our Mother, the Earth. It reminds us of our human frailty and instability. While we are completely dependent on everything in Creation to sustain us, that same Creation would survive and flourish without us.

It is an incredible honour to be able to continue these ancient traditions on our original territories in our original languages. It speaks to the fortitude and resilience of our ancestors that we continue to share our traditional Haudenosaunee teachings with the newcomers to our lands.

While there is a general, overall pattern to the Ohén:ton Karihwatékhwen, there is not a single correct version. It is unique to the individual who has been chosen to put those words through on our behalf. The version a speaker chooses will depend on the situation and the reason for the gathering. When we are in ceremony and being thankful is of primary importance, a speaker may take up to an hour to complete the recitation. In other situations the length of the Address will be shortened to a simple grocery list similar to the one that is delivered in social functions such as this convocation. It could take as little as five minutes.

A general outline of the address is provided on the next page.

Indigenous Thanksgiving continued

First, the Orator will start with a call out to those present to listen closely and set aside a moment to remember.

He/she will then turn our minds towards the Earth and remind us to be thankful to:

Onkwe'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of people that we may continue to be peaceful as we mingle and travel about on Earth

Yethinihsténha Onhwéntsya, Our Mother the Earth

Kahnekahrényon, The many different waters & Kentsyon'shon:'a, the many different types and kinds of fishes

Ohonte'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of grasses, Ononhkwa'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of natural growing medicines & Ohtera'shón:'a, The many different types and kinds of roots

Tyonnhéhkwen, The Life Sustaining plant life

Kahikshón:'a, The many different kinds of hanging fruits

Otsi'nonwa'shón:'a, The many different kinds of insects

Kontíryo, the Free-roaming, wild animals

Karonta'shón:'a, The many different kinds of trees

Otsi'ten'okón:'a, The many different kinds of birds

He/she will then turn our minds towards the Skyworld and remind us to be thankful to all of the life-giving forces of the sky:

Yonkhihshot'okón:'a Ratiwéras, Our Grandfathers, the Thunderers

Kayé:ri Nikawerá:ke, The Four winds

Shonkwahtsi:'a Entye'kenékha Karáhkwa, Our Older Brother the Sun

Yethi'shótha Ahsontennékha Karáhkwa, Our Grandmother the Moon

Yotsihstohkwarónnyon, The Night-time Stars

Kayé:ri niyonkwè:take, The Four Beings

Shonkwaya'tíson, Our Creator

The speaker will then turn back to the people gathered and reiterate that he did the best that he was able and if anything had been missed or forgotten that the people can make it right in their minds.

Tahnon O:nen E'tho. And there that is how it shall be.



2018 Honorary Degree Recipients

PERRIN BEATTY Presented on October 26, 1:00 pm



The Honourable Perrin Beatty has had a truly remarkable career as a corporate executive and former politician. A year after graduating from the University of Western Ontario, Mr. Beatty was elected to the House of Commons at the age of 22. In 1979, he became (at the time) the youngest person ever appointed to Cabinet. From 1972-1993, Mr. Beatty served as the Minister of Parliament for Wellington-Dufferin-Simcoe (PC). His portfolios spanned the Treasury Board, National Revenue, Solicitor General,

Defence, National Health and Welfare, Communications and External Affairs. After his departure from politics, Mr. Beatty forged an equally impressive corporate career including President and CEO of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, President and CEO of the Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters and, currently, President and CEO of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce. He was named an Officer of the Order of Canada in June.

STEPHEN PATRICK BRUNT Presented on October 27, 9:30 am



With over 30 years of experience as a sports writer and broadcaster, Stephen Brunt has excelled to become a leader in Canadian sports journalism. After graduating from the University of Western Ontario with a Master of Arts in journalism, Mr. Brunt started his career as an intern with The Globe and Mail. After covering the 1984 election, his focus shifted to the sports section where he reported less on the game, and more about the culture, politics and economics in the world of sports, earning

him many nominations for National Newspaper Awards. Mr. Brunt has authored seven books and co-hosted radio shows on CHUM Radio Network and Fan 590. In 2010, he was an Olympic Torch Carrier. Today, he continues to report for Sportsnet. Mr. Brunt's notable awards include a Michener Award for public service journalism for his series on negligence and corruption in boxing (1988), and induction to the Canadian Football Hall of Fame (2007).

RUTH E. ABERNETHY Presented on October 30, 2:30 pm



Ruth Abernethy has had an extraordinary artistic career, with notable contributions to theatre and Canada's national visual arts record. Ms. Abernethy started working in professional theatre at the age of 17. After graduating from Malaspina University-College (Nanaimo, BC) she was employed by organizations like the Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre, Stratford Festival, Louisville Ballet and the National Ballet of Canada. In the mid-eighties, Ms. Abernethy enhanced her visual arts experience

when she received a Canada Council grant to travel to Japan and Europe. Since then, Ms. Abernethy's visual arts practice has produced many beautiful bronze sculptures that reside in public and private collections around the world. Her studio practice also includes sculptural installations in metals, textiles and multimedia. In 2005, she won a bursary to be the first Canadian exhibitor in Sydney, Australia's Sculpture by The Sea. Following this, she won an Award of Excellence in the 2008 Beijing Sculpture Competition.

JAMIE MARTIN Presented on October 27, 1:00 pm



Jamie Martin is a notable figure throughout the Region of Waterloo for his leadership, community service and career. Mr. Martin graduated from the University of Windsor with a LL.B. (1974) and was admitted to the Ontario Bar in 1976. In his 42 years of service, Mr. Martin progressed to become an eminent member and partner of Miller Thomson LLP, maintaining a high BV rating by Martindale-Hubbell for legal ability and ethical standards. As an active volunteer in the community, Mr. Martin has participated in the leadership of many notable

organizations like Canada's Technology Triangle, Kitchener-Waterloo Art Gallery, Kitchener-Waterloo Kinsmen Club and Charitable Foundation, and the Centre for Family Business at UW. Mr. Martin has been an active member of the Law Society of Ontario, the Waterloo Law Association and the Kitchener Rotary Club. In 2009, Mr. Martin became a member of Laurier's Board of Governors, appointed by Order of Lieutenant Governor in Council. He served as chair of the Board from 2013-2015 and was an instrumental representative of the university during a period of new strategic directions.
