Orientation Week events welcome first-year students to Laurier's Brantford campus

BRANTFORD – Wilfrid Laurier University will welcome about 800 first-year students to its Brantford campus with a series of **Orientation Week** events taking place **Sept. 2 to 7**.

<u>Orientation Week</u>, organized by the Wilfrid Laurier University Students' Union, is an opportunity for students to learn their way around campus, meet new people and become involved in student life.

"Orientation Week is filled with activities and events to help integrate incoming students into the Laurier and Brantford communities," said **Adam Lawrence, dean of students** for the Brantford campus. "The Students' Union, Student Affairs staff, faculty members and senior student volunteers have been working extremely hard to create a transition program to help prepare students for academic and personal success in the coming year."

Events throughout the week include **Shine Day**, when students wash cars to raise money for Cystic Fibrosis Canada, brunch with the mayor, a carnival in Harmony Square and a room-burn demonstration by firefighters to promote fire safety. Throughout the week, students will also learn about safety and support services at Laurier, resources to help them balance their physical and mental health, and tips and advice for academic success. Orientation Week will begin with opening ceremonies on Monday, Sept. 2 at the Sanderson Centre for the Performing Arts, featuring a keynote and comedy show by **Andy Thibodeau**.

On Tuesday, Sept. 3, Brantford Fire Department firefighters will ignite and suppress a fire in a model bedroom to show how quickly a fire can spread and demonstrate the importance of smoke alarms and having an evacuation plan. The room burn demonstration takes place in the in the rear parking lot of 50 Wellington Street.

On Wednesday, Sept. 4, **Mike Domitrz**, author and co-founder of <u>The Center for Respect</u> (formerly the Date Safe Project), will present **Can I Kiss You?**, an interactive presentation tackling dating, intimacy, consent and sexual assault.

The **Mayor's Brunch** takes place on Wednesday, Sept. 4, with Mayor Kevin Davis and local councillors serving brunch to first-year students in Harmony Square as an official welcome to Brantford.
