- ASPIRE, a professional skills development training program to help position graduate students and postdoctoral fellows for post-degree success.
- Tuition subsidies for employees to continue their education.
- Early Career Researcher awards, a university-wide recognition of exceptional early-career faculty members who make significant contributions to research.
- Three weeks of paid vacation for new employees after their first year on the job.

In 2020, Laurier was named one of <u>Canada's greenest employers for the second year in a row</u> and received a Waterloo Area Top Employer Award for the third straight year.
