UNIVERSITY CHANCELLOR NAMED

BRANTFORD 'CITIZEN OF THE YEAR'

Senator W. Ross Macdonald, chancellor of Waterloo Lutheran
University and former speaker of the House of Commons, is Brantford's
Citizen of the Year.

He was selected by the Brantford Junior Chamber of Commerce which will honor Chancellor Macdonald at a testimonial dinner Feb. 24.

Among those bringing greetings will be Dr. William J. Villaume, president of Waterloo Lutheran University.

Active in politics since 1921, Chancellor Macdonald entered the Commons in 1935 as the member for Brantford. He was appointed deputy speaker in 1945 and speaker in 1949. In 1953 he was appointed to the Senate and made a member of the Queen's privy council. He was solicitor-general from 1954 to 1957.

He is a regular visitor to the campus, beloved by faculty and students alike. Last year he turned lecturer as well, giving a series of talks on functions of the Canadian Senate.
