STEEL CONTRACT AWARDED FOR NEW WLU BUILDING

DUNKER CONSTRUCTION LIMITED OF KITCHENER HAS BEEN AWARDED

THE STEEL CONTRACT FOR THE STUDENT UNION BUILDING WHICH IS

TO BE ERECTED ON THE CAMPUS OF WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY.

THIS BUILDING HAS BEEN DESIGNED AND WILL BE USED SPECIFICALLY

FOR STUDENT ACTIVITIES.

THE TWO STOREY, 10,000 SQ. FT. STRUCTURE CONTAINS AMPLE SPACE FOR OFFICES, LOUNGES AND MEETING ROOMS FOR THE VARIOUS CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS. THE MEETING ROOMS WILL HAVE FLEXIBLE PARTITIONS THUS ENABLING THREE OR FOUR ROOMS TO BE MADE INTO ONE WHEN EXTRA SPACE IS REQUIRED.

THE BUILDING IS THE SECOND STAGE OF THE FOUR UNIT ENCLOSED COURT WHICH IS BEING ERECTED BESIDE THE WOMEN'S RESIDENCE. CONSTRUCTION ON THIS BUILDING WILL BE STARTED LATER THIS MONTH AND THE WORK WILL BE FINISHED FOR THE 1962 FALL TERM. THE COST OF THE STRUCTURE, AND FUTURE MAINTENANCE COST, IS BEING MET IN PART BY A STUDENT UNION BUILDING FUND WHICH WAS ESTABLISHED BY THE STUDENT BODY OF 1957 - 1958 AND WHICH HAS BEEN AUGMENTED EACH YEAR BY THE STUDENTS.
