GUIDANCE SEMINARS...TAKE I

GUIDANCE SEMINARS SCHEDULED
BY WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE

WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE WILL CONDUCT A SERIES OF GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING SEMINARS FOR THREE TUESDAY EVENINGS BEGINNING FEBRUARY 19TH, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY BY DEAN LLOYD H. SCHAUS. INVITATIONS HAVE BEEN ISSUED TO DIRECTORS OF GUIDANCE OF MORE THAN 40 HIGH SCHOOLS AND COLLEGIATE INSTITUTES. WATERLOO UNIVERSITY COLLEGE IS THE ARTS FACULTY OF WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY.

THE SEMINARS ARE DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR PERSONS WORKING IN COUNSELING AT THE HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL AND FOR OTHERS WHO ARE DIRECTLY INVOLVED WITH PROBLEMS OF THE ADOLESCENT. THE SESSIONS WILL BEGIN AT 8 P.M. EACH TUESDAY EVENING.

NEXT TUESDAY'S SESSION, TO BE HELD IN THE MUSIC ROOM OF THE ARTS BUILDING, WILL BE ADDRESSED BY DR. W.F. KOERBER, SUPERVISOR OF SPECIAL EDUCATION FOR THE SCARBOROUGH BOARD OF EDUCATION. HIS TOPIC WILL BE "STANDARD AND SPECIAL: THE NEEDS AND CHARACTERISTICS OF ADOLESCENTS."

THE SERIES WILL ALSO COVER SUCH TOPICS AS "SOME ASSUMPTIONS UNDERLYING VOCATIONAL COUNSELING," "THE HEART OF THE MATTER," "COUNSELING BY INTERVIEW", AND "WHOSE OBJECTIVES CAN WE SERVE -- STUDENTS, PARENTS, OR SOCIETY?"
