LABOUR PROBLEMS TO BE DISCUSSED AT FINAL INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT COURSE AT WLU

THE EXECUTIVE VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE CANADIAN LABOUR CONGRESS, WILLIAM DODGE, OF OTTAWA, WILL SPEAK NEXT MONDAY EVENING ON "LABOUR'S APPROACH TO THE PROBLEMS OF CANADA'S EXPORT TRADE" AT THE 13TH AND FINAL SESSION OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT COURSE BEING HELD AT WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY.

NO SESSION WAS HELD THIS WEEK DUE TO THE ELECTION.

WITH A WIDE BACKGROUND OF EXPERIENCE IN THE LABOUR MOVEMENT, AND EXECUTIVE VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE C.L.C. SINCE 1958, MR. DODGE WILL ADDRESS AN AUDIENCE OF BUSINESS LEADERS AND STUDENTS VITALLY INTERESTED IN LABOUR'S VIEW-POINT TO THE EXPORT PROBLEM. IN HIS LAST VISIT TO KITCHENER-WATERLOO IN JANUARY, HE ADDRESSED THE NOW FAMOUS LABOUR-MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP ATTEMPTING TO DEVELOP ALONG EUROPEAN LINES, A CLOSER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN BUSINESS AND ORGANIZED LABOUR.
