LIBRARY WILL BE DEDICATED

DURING PARENTS ORIENTATION DAY

The first stage of Waterloo Lutheran University's new 1,100,000 library will be dedicated Saturday during Parents Orientation Day.

The big day will see students, grads members of the Board. of Governors, the Senate and. parents and friends gather on the campus to see the new building, the 14th. campus unit since 1961, officially opened.

The service of dedication will be held. in the Theatre-Auditorium, with the Hon. Walter F. Schroeder, justice of the Supreme Court of Ontario and member of the WLU Senate, as guest speaker.

Following the academic processions and. official dedication ceremony, the new building will be thrown open. to guests, with guided. tours provided by librarian, Rev. Erich Schultz and. his staff.

The building is as yet unfinished, only the first stage, two floors, are completed, Ultimately the building will rise seven. stories, growing as the need for space becomes more acute.

The service begins at 3:45 P.M.

Campus tours, to give the parents an opportunity to see the main changes made during the year, will get underway at 11:00 'A.M., and at 11:30 A.M. Mrs. R. J. Peterson, Municipal Regent of the Kitchener-Waterloo chapter of the Imperial Order, Daughters of the Empire, will present a new flag pole to the university.

Dr. Frederick J. Speckeen, Dean of students, will convene a parents assembly at which Dr. William J. Villaume, President of WLU; Dr. Lloyd A. Schaus, Dean of Waterloo University College; Miss Esther Brandon, Dean of women; Dr. Henry Endress, Vice-president, director of university resources; and David. Pady, President of the Students Council, will be speakers.

The day will close with a buffet supper, and a musicale sponsored. by the Alumni Association.
