WLU ALUMNI TO SPONSOR

OBSERVATORY PROJECT

Graduates and former students of Waterloo Lutheran University will reach for the stars by sponsoring the erection of a telescopic dome for the proposed science and business administration building.

The decision of the university's Alumni Association was announced at a dinner honoring Dr. Carl Klinck, former dean of arts, as Alumni of the Year, at the Walper Hotel here.

Bev L. Hayes of Waterloo, chairman of the first and second Alumni Loyalty Funds, said an observatory will become an integral part of the university's growing science program and become a focal point on campus.

Earlier, alumni presented \$12,162 for the alumni foyer in the new library building, and \$1,382 from the class of '64 as the first instalment toward a seminar room in the same building.

Dr. Klinck, now senior professor of English at the University of Western Ontario, speaking at the annual Alumni dinner, reviewed the growth of the university from its beginnings in 1911.

"Colleges and even universities, can be created by an act of legislature," he said.

"But we have here what it took 40 years to build: a college and university truly shaped by the community and a community enriched by the college and university."

The weekend opened with a concert by the world-famed Oscar Peterson trio and closed with three dances on campus.
