## BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR HEADS

### COLLEGE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

John Gellner, business administrator of St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Kitchener, is the new president of the Alumni Association of Waterloo University College, the arts and science faculty of Waterloo Lutheran University. He succeeds Tom Freure, of Waterloo.

Alumni members voted also to sponsor a telescopic dome as the first stage of an observatory for the proposed science and business administration building.

Last year's project was sponsorship of an alumni foyer and a seminar room in the new library building. A cheque for \$13,544 was presented on behalf of alumni by Bev L. Hayes, of Waterloo, chairman of the first and second Alumni Loyalty Funds.
