REGISTRAR FOR ADMISSIONS NAMED

BY WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY

Paul T. Holliday, a Scarborough high school guidance instructor and ordained Baptist clergyman, has been appointed assistant registrar for admissions of Waterloo Lutheran University.

His appointment was announced today by Dr. William J. Villaume, WLU president.

Mr. Holliday, 36, will assist Registrar Henry Dueck and will have special responsibility in providing admissions information and will serve as university spokesman in visits to the province's high schools.

For the past three years Mr. Holliday has taught English and guidance at the Eastern High School of Commerce, Toronto. He also was a part-time instructor in English literature at the Toronto Baptist Seminary and evening instructor in English for the Toronto Board of Education.

He was graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree from Waterloo Lutheran University in 1962 and received Bachelor of Divinity and Master of Theology degrees from the Toronto Baptist Seminary.

A pastor for 14 years, he served the Willowdale Baptist Church and Scarborough Baptist Church in addition to his student pastorates. He was ordained in 1953.

Dr. Villaume said the appointment of Mr. Holliday is another step in Waterloo Lutheran University's program to tell its story to high school students considering a university career. Waterloo Lutheran, with courses in arts, science, business administration and theology, is the only church-sponsored university in the province and operates without provincial tax aid and with a limited enrolment.
