WINS TRIP TO GERMANY

Heidi Conrad, a second year honors French and German student at Waterloo Lutheran University, has won an all-expense scholarship from the Goethe Institute of Munich for study in Germany this summer.

Miss Conrad, a daughter of Mr. and. Mrs. Kurt Conrad, 391 Edwin St., Kitchener, will attend a language, literature and art course from July 1 to August 27. The scholarship was obtained through the university's department of German and the German Embassy at Ottawa.

Five other German-language students will work in Germany for the summer, leaving May 20. The German Embassy arranged for the students to get reduced air fares and, assisted them in finding employment. There will be opportunity for travel, including a week's visit to Berlin.
