INSTALLATION OF THE CHANCELLOR

The Vice-Chancellor and President, Dr. Frank C. Peters, will preside until the Chancellor is installed in office.

The Chairman of the Board of Governors, Rev. Robert Binhammer, will announce the election and administer the oath of office.

"Will the Chancellor-elect please rise"

"Mr. Chairman, I have great pleasure in presenting the Honorable Paul Martin, Leader of the Senate, Member of the Privy Council, Queen's Council, Doctor of Laws and Doctor of Humanities, who has been duly elected by the Board of Governors as Chancellor of this University."

"Do you, therefore, Paul Martin assume the function and office of Chancellor of this University and do you pledge yourself to keep and preserve well and faithfully, during your period of office, the statutes, liberties, customs, rights and privileges of the University, and to promote its well being and that of its members so far as in you lies."

The Chancellor-elect will reply:

"I, Paul Martin undertake in the strength which God shall give me to perform to the best of my ability the duty of Chancellor of Waterloo Lutheran University; and I promise, as the highest academic officer of this University, to defend its rights and promote its welfare."

The Chairman of the Senate and Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Frank C. Peters will install the Chancellor-elect in the office of Chancellor.

"As Chairman of the Senate and as Vice-Chancellor of the University, I now install you Paul Martin in the office of Chancellor, and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Senate and the Board of Governors, charge you with the responsibilities which appertain to that high office."

"I now request the Vice-Chairman of the Senate to robe you in the official gown and cap of the Chancellor of Waterloo Lutheran University."

The Vice-Chairman of the Senate, Dr. Neale H. Tayler, assisted by the Secretary of the Senate, Mr. Henry H. Dueck, and Dr. Delton J. Glebe will robe the Chancellor.

The Bedel, Dr. Klaus H. Bongart will present the Mace of the University to the Chancellor.

"Mr. Chancellor, I hereby present to you the Mace of Waterloo Lutheran University and ask that you accept it as a symbol of your authority."

The Chancellor will accept the Mace.

"I accept the Mace and ask that you place it in position before me to signify the commencement of Convocation."

REMARKS: Chancellor Paul Martin

On conclusion of his remarks the Chancellor will declare the Convocation to be in session.

"I declare this Convocation to be in session and call upon the Vice-Chancellor to present the candidates for degrees and diplomas."
