WLU BUSINESS SEMINAR STUDIES

PACKAGE WEIGHT CONTROL

Twenty-six business executives are spending two days at Waterloo Lutheran University February 13 - 14 learning how to improve profits by careful package weight control.

They are attending a workshop-seminar organized by the business administration department of Waterloo University College, the arts faculty of Waterloo Lutheran University. This is the second in a series of workshop-seminars for management offered by the university.

The 26 businessmen registered for the seminar represent 23 companies from Montreal, Quebec, to Sarnia, Ontario. Topics covered in the course include evaluation, setting and control of filling equipment.

Leader of the seminar is Dr. Brant Bonner, professor of Business

Administration at WUC. Dr. Bonner is a consultant and former staff supervisor of industrial statistics for The Dow Chemical Co., Midland, Michigan. He has had experience in establishing package weight control programs in industry and has presented papers on the subject to technical groups, including the American Society for Quality Control.
