AS WUC ALUMNUS-OF-THE-YEAR

Dr. Walter F. Koerber, director of the youth branch of the Ontario

Department of Education, has been named 1964 Alumnus-of-the-Year of Waterloo

University College, the arts and science faculty of Waterloo Lutheran University,

This is announced today by Alumni Association president, Pablo M. Machetzki.

Dr. Koerber will be presented with his award at the university's homecoming weekend dinner-dance at Bingeman Park, Kitchener, on Saturday, October 31, and will be guest speaker at the dinner.

Entering Waterloo College in 1927, he graduated with the degree of Bachelor of Arts in 1930. His post-graduate work was done at the University of Toronto, where he received his bachelor's degree in education in 1934 and his doctorate in education in 1947.

Before his appointment last July as director of the newly-created youth branch, Dr. Koerber had made a special six-month study of all the organizations, agencies and services related to youth in Ontario. He was previously inspector of public schools, Scarborough.

He is an elder of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church, Scarborough, and a member of the board of directors of the Toronto Children's Aid Society. He is the father of four daughters, one of them, Mrs. Katherine Weigel, a 1963 graduate of Waterloo University College.

Opening event of the university's homecoming weekend will be a concert in the WLU theatre-auditorium by Israeli pianist Daniel Barenboim on Friday, October 30. The concert will mark the presentation to the university of a Steinway concert grand piano by the Alumni Association.
