FIRST FAMILY DAY WILL BE HELD AT

WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY FEB. 13

A "Family Day" -- the first of its kind ever organized by Waterloo Lutheran University -- will be held at WLU on Saturday, February 13.

Campus Life in Action will be the theme of the day, to which parents and families of students are being invited.

"Following the success of the Parents Orientation Day held in the fall, the Family Day will give families the chance to take part in many phases of campus life," said Mr. Reginald Lillyman of Toronto, president of the WLU Parents Association.

The day's program will begin with a family assembly in the theatre-auditorium. Speakers will be the university chancellor, Senator W. Ross Macdonald; WLU president, Dr. William J. Villaume; dean of Waterloo University College (the arts and science faculty of WLU), Dr. Lloyd H. Schaus; dean of students, Dr. Frederick J. Speckeen; student council president, Larry E. Hansen, of Chatham, Ontario; and Mr. Lillyman. A discussion and question period will follow.

Open house campus tours, laboratory demonstrations, faculty consultations, choir concerts and supper entertainment will take place during the afternoon.

At night families will attend the final performance of the university's "Purple and Gold Show" -- "Guys and Dolls" -- in the theatre-auditorium.
