PROMINENT TORONTO LAWYER NAMED

TO WATERLOO LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY SENATE

George S. P. Ferguson, QC, senior partner in the Toronto law firm of Ferguson, Montgomery, Cassels and Mitchell, has been named to the senate of Waterloo Lutheran University. His term is for three years.

The senate is the university body that recommends academic programs and policies to the Board of Governors, affecting all faculties and schools of the university.

Mr. Ferguson, who is the legal counsel for the university in union negotiations, was called to the bar in 1943 and appointed Queen's Counsel in 1959. He is past president of the board of governors of the Ontario March of Dimes.

A Toronto man, Mr. Ferguson received his B.A. degree in political science and economics from Trinity College, University of Toronto, and then attended Osgoode Hall law school.
