SEARCH FOR END TO LOSING STREAK

The hockey and basketball teams of Waterloo Lutheran University will be looking for an end to their present losing streak this Saturday when both teams see action.

The hockey HAWKS, having lost their last four games, will be out to upset the University of Windsor LANCERS in an exhibition game Saturday afternoon.

The game will be played at the Kitchener Memorial Auditorium starting at 2 p.m.

The HAWKS' losses were 7-0 and 6-3 to the University of Waterloo WARRIORS and 9-4 and 6-2 trouncings to the University of Michigan. All have been exhibition games.

In their first outings of the season in the Ontario Intercollegiate hockey circuit the HAWKS defeated Ryerson and Osgoode Hall.

The basketball HAWKS are also hoping to end a three game losing streak in exhibition play when they host the Laurentian University VOYAGEURS of Sudbury in an Ontario Intercollegiate Basketball game at the WLU Theatre-Auditorium.

Game time is 8 p.m.

The HAWKS will be looking for their forty-first straight O.I.A.A. league win on Saturday against the VOYAGEURS. The HAWKS are defending O.I.A.A. basketball champions.

The three losses suffered by the HAWKS were at the hands of Ontario-Quebec Intercollegiate teams, the University of Windsor LANCERS, the McMaster MARAUDERS, and the University of Waterloo WARRIORS.
