Prof. Glenn Carroll Named Acting Director
of School of Business and Economics

Prof. Glenn Carroll, associate professor of business administration in Waterloo Lutheran University's school of business and economics, today was named acting director of the school.

He succeeds Dr. Herman Overgaard, who is leaving the directorship to return to full-time teaching as a professor in the school.

Prof. Carroll, an alumnus of Waterloo Lutheran University, has been a WLU faculty member since 1960. He began his career as a public school teacher and then became an executive in industrial relations, advertising and public relations before joining the faculty.

when the former department of business became the WLU school of business and economics last year he was named chairman of the department of personnel and marketing. Last October he was awarded a \$ 2,500 Seagram Business Fellowship for university professors in doctoral programs.

The new acting director received his B.A. degree from WLU, a master's degree in business administration from the University of Western Ontario, and is completing his thesis work for his Ph.D. from the University of Buffalo.

Dr. Frank C. Peters, acting vice-president: academic and dean of arts and science praised Prof. Carroll as an able teacher who commands the respect of faculty and students. "He is well-known in the world of commerce and industry as a capable and aggressive leader."

And the acting president, Dr. Henry Endress, added that Prof. Carroll is an effective administrator, nationally known as an outstanding communicator with the ability to develop his associates into a working team.
