WLU GOLDEN HAWKS OPEN

## DEFENCE OF FOOTBALL TITLE

Waterloo Lutheran University GOLDEN HAWKS will be out to defend their 1966 Ontario Intercollegiate Football Conference title when they travel to the University of Guelph to play the GRYPHONS on Friday night.

The contest will be the first one for the HAWKS in the newly created Central Canada Intercollegiate Football Conference and their first game since they defeated the University of Western Ontario MUSTANGS 30-21 in a game played in London two weeks ago.

The HAWKS will be looking for another undefeated season in league play when they meet the Guelph squad who had a 4-5 won-lost record last season.

Head coach, Dave Knight, will have an opportunity to see a few more of his players in action. The 50 HAWKS who attended camp will have to be cut down to 30 players for the first league game of the season.

Coach Knight is looking for good performances from returning lettermen, Murray Markowitz, Dave McKay, John Kruspe, Paul Markle, Mike McMahon and Ralph Spoltore. Doug Strong who came to the HAWKS from Simon Fraser University in British Columbia has also been impressive in practices and in the Western game.

The first home game of the HAWKS will be Friday, October 6 when the HAWKS play host to the Loyola University WARRIORS from Montreal.
