Hockey Hawks Looking for Winning Ways,

Cage Hawks Play warriors

The hockey Hawks will be searching for a winning combination in league play when they host Ryerson Rams at the Kitchener Memorial Auditorium on Thursday, February 1, at 8 p.m.

The Hawks have lost their last three league encounters, their latest defeat coming at the hands of Laurentian University Voyageurs last Saturday by a 5-2 score.

The Hawks sport a 5-4 won-lost record in league play having lost twice to Laurentian, and once each to York and Ryerson.

Meanwhile, the basketball Hawks play the University of Waterloo warriors in a non-conference game at Seagram gym on Wednesday, Jan. 31 at 8:15 p.m.

The junior varsity squads will play in the preliminary game.

wednesday's game should create a great deal of excitement in Waterloo as the two rival teams meet. In their first game of the year the Hawks defeated the warriors 94-77.

The warriors are currently in first-place in the Ontario Quebec Athletic Association with a 4-0 won-lost record and the Golden Hawks are again dominating the Ontario Intercollegiate Athletic Association for their fourth straight year.

In league play the Hawks have won 52 of their last 53 games. In non-conference play against teams of the O.Q.A.A. this year the Hawks have won six games by decisive scores and have lost only twice.

On Friday, Feb. 2 the Hawks swing back into league action when they host Ryerson Rams in an O.I.A.A. league basketball game in the Theatre-Auditorium at 8 p.m.

In their previous encounter the Hawks defeated the Rams 97-55.

On Saturday, Feb. 3 the Golden Hawks host a team from St. John Fisher College of Rochester, N.Y. St. John Fisher previously downed the Hawks 71-66 in a game played in Rochester early in December.

Saturday's game will begin at 8 p.m. in the WLU Theatre-Auditorium.
